



1. Front of CS9 without auto drains.




2. Front of CS9 with auto drains.



3. Oil sight gauge




4. Adding oil: remove the oil cap and open the oil vent.






5. Changing the carbon filter

Maintenance Schedule

(this must be followed or the warrantee is void.)

Hours	Description		
Every run	Check oil level(s).		
Every 15 min.	Empty all THREE condensate H20 drains, if no auto drains.		
25	First oil change!!! This is an important change.		
25	Check intake filter & check belt tension.		
38 hrs/150 hrs	Change carbon air filter on <u>5 hp</u> motor.		
	2 nd number is hours with extra filter. *		
21 hrs/112 hrs	Change carbon air filter <u>7.5 hp</u> motor.*		
Every 125	Change intake filter		
Every 250	Regular oil change or once per year.		
Yearly	Change oil and filters, even if you do not have the hours.		

^{*} Temperature Correction Table: In order to know the actual number of hours that a filter will last, see the chart below.

Celsius	Fahrenheit	Conversion Factor	actual hours filter will last Example: hours (eg. 38 hours) x factor = actual hours
50	122	.2	7.6 hours
40	104	.34	12.92 hours
30	86	.57	21.7 hours
